Steady Red Arrow =
Drivers turning left must stop
and wait



Steady Yellow Arrow =
Stop if you can do so safely



Flashing Yellow Arrow =
Proceed with left turn after
yielding to oncoming traffic
and pedestrians (Oncoming
traffic has a green light!)



Steady Green Arrow =
Proceed with left turn

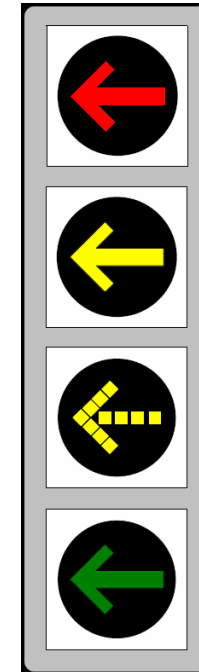

Flashing Yellow Left-Turn Arrow Signal

at
Pima Mine Road and Rancho
Sahuarita Boulevard

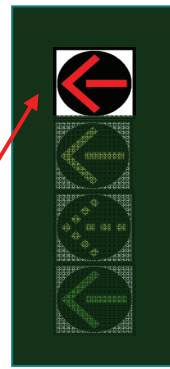


Flashing yellow left-turn arrow signals are being introduced nationwide, and have been shown to provide safer and more efficient travel through an intersection. The new signals provide an opportunity for motorists to turn left after yielding to oncoming traffic.

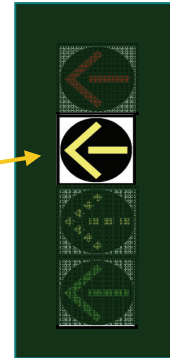


The green arrow (which follows the flashing yellow arrow) provides a protected left turn while the flashing yellow arrow indicates that left-turning traffic must first yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians before turning. The steady yellow and red arrows work the same way as they always have.

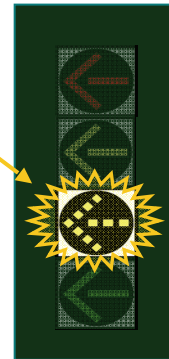
Drivers will see one of four lights as they approach Rancho Sahuarita Boulevard from the east on Pima Mine Road:



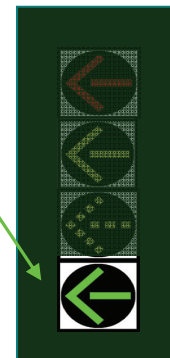
Steady Red Arrow - Drivers turning left must stop and wait



Steady Yellow Arrow - Drivers are warned the left-turn signal is about to turn red. Do not enter the intersection if you can stop safely. Vehicles in the intersection should complete their turn.



Flashing Yellow Arrow - Drivers are allowed to turn left after yielding to oncoming traffic and pedestrians. (Oncoming traffic has a green light.) Drivers must determine if there is an adequate gap before turning!



Steady Green Arrow - Drivers making a left turn have the right-of-way. This sequence may be skipped if no left-turning vehicles are detected by the signal system.
